UNINTENDED EQUIPMENT OPERATION

 Do not use the unit as the only means of control for critical system functions such as motor start/stop or power control.

LOSS OF CONTROL

- The designer of any control scheme must consider the potential failure modes of control paths and, for certain critical control functions, provide a means to achieve a safe state during and after a path failure.
- The machine control system design must take into account the possibility
 of the backlight no longer functioning and the operator being unable to
 control the machine, or making errors in the control of the machine.



*1. The front face of the unit, installed in a solid panel, has been tested using conditions equivalent to the standards shown in the specification. Even though the unit's level of resistance is equivalent to the UL50E TYPE 4X, oils that should have no effect on the unit can possibly harm the panel. This can occur in areas where either vaporized oils are present, or where low viscosity cutting oils are allowed to adhere to the panel for long periods of time. If the unit's front face protection sheet peels off, these conditions can lead to the ingress of oil into the unit and separate protection measures are suggested.

Also, if non-approved oils are present, they may cause deformation or corrosion of the front panel's plastic cover. Therefore, prior to installing the unit, be sure to confirm the type of conditions that will be present in the unit's operating environment. If the installation gasket is used for a long period of time, or if the unit and its gasket are removed from the panel, the original level of protection cannot be kept. To maintain the original protection level, the periodical maintenance is essential

Note:

 A gasket with scratches or dirt could have lost much of its water resistance. The periodical maintenance is essential (e.g. once a year, or as soon as scratches or dirt become visible) for water resistance equivalent to IP65.


POTENTIAL FOR EXPLOSION

- Verify that the power, input and output (I/O) wiring are in accordance with Class I, Division 2 wiring methods.
- Substitution of any component may impair suitability for Class I, Division
- Do not disconnect equipment while the circuit is live or unless the area is known to be free of ignitable gases concentrations.
- Remove power before attaching or detaching any connectors to or from this product.
- Ensure that power, communication, and accessory connections do not place excessive stress on the ports. Consider the vibration in the environment when making this determination.
- Securely attach power, communication, and external accessory cables to the panel or cabinet.
- Suitable for use in Class I, Division 2, Groups A, B, C, and D Hazardous Locations.
- Confirm that the USB cable has been attached with the USB cable clamp before using the USB interface.



Step	Action		
1	Create a panel cut-out and insert the unit into the panel from the front. The following illustration shows the panel cut-out for the unit:

2	Insert the unit into the panel hole. Screw in the nut using torque of 1.22 N•m (10.6217.70 lb-in) 1		
	Note: Install the 2 mm spacer (Option) when the panel thickness is mm (0.04 in.) or more, and less than 1.5 mm (0.06 in.). The spacer is unnecessary if the panel thickness is 1.5 mm (0.06 in.) or more. Remove the USB cable before removing the unit. If using an anti-rotation tee, insert it into the unit securely.

2	Insert the USB cable into the USB (Type mini-B) interface on the unit. Insert the USB clamp into the mounting hole.	

Removal

1	Hold the locking tab of the clamp and pull to remove it.

1	Peel off the protective sheet of the function key label.		
2	Print a new label onto the function key label. Note:
