## **Operating System Setup**

The instructions below describe the setup procedure for Windows<sup>®</sup>. Settings that need to be configured will differ depending on system configuration. Check with the network administrator beforehand and configure settings correctly.

### NOTE

 Use a commercially available USB keyboard and mouse when setting up the operating system.

- 1. Windows<sup>®</sup> XP Professional Multi Language
- (1) When you turn on this product with Windows<sup>®</sup> XP Professional Multi Language pre-installed, a message saying "Welcome to the Windows XP Setup Wizard" appears. Click "Next".
- (2) The "License Agreement" window appears. Read the license agreement carefully, click "I accept this agreement", and then click "Next".
- (3) The "Regional and Language Options" window appears. Change the settings as desired. Click "Next".
- (4) The "Personalize Your Software" window appears. Type your user name and other details and then click "Next".
- (5) The "Computer Name and Administrator Password" window appears. To set a password, check with the network administrator and complete the "Computer name", "Administrator password", and "Confirm password" fields, then click "Next".
- (6) The "Date and Time Settings" window appears. Check this product's date and time settings and click "Next".
- (7) The "Networking Settings" window appears. Choose whether to use "Typical settings" or "Custom settings", and then click "Next".
- (8) The "Workgroup or Computer Domain" window appears. Choose whether to make this product a member of the domain. To make this product a member of the domain, type the domain name in the box. Click "Next".

- (9) The "Performing Final Tasks" window appears, and the operating system setup begins. When setup is complete, this product automatically restarts. Do not operate this product until the system setup is completed. It might take time
- 2. Windows<sup>®</sup> Embedded Standard 2009
- (1) When you turn on this product with Windows<sup>®</sup> Embedded Standard 2009 pre-installed, operating system setup automatically starts and finishes, and this product automatically restarts. Do not operate this product until the system setup is completed. It might take time.
- 3. Windows® 7 Ultimate
- (1) When you turn on this product with Windows<sup>®</sup>7 Ultimate pre-installed, the Windows<sup>®</sup> 7 Ultimate setup window appears. Choose a language and click "Next".
- (2) Enter your language and other preferences and click "Next".
- (3) Enter a user name and computer name that can be recognized on the network, and click "Next".
- (4) A window for configuring user account security settings appears. Set a password and click "Next".
- (5) Read the license terms, click "I accept the license terms", and then click "Next".
- (6) The "Review your time and date settings" window appears. Choose a time zone and click "Next".
- (7) Operating system setup starts.
  When setup is complete, this product automatically restarts.
   Do not operate this product until the

system setup is completed. It might take time.

- 4. Windows<sup>®</sup> Embedded Standard 7
- (1) When you turn on this product with Windows<sup>®</sup> Embedded Standard 7 pre-installed, the Windows<sup>®</sup> Embedded Standard 7 setup window appears. Choose a language and click "Next".
- (2) Enter your language and other preferences and click "Next".
- (3) The "Review your time and date settings" window appears. Choose a time zone and click "Next".
- (4) Operating system setup starts. When setup is complete, this product automatically restarts.

Do not operate this product until the system setup is completed. It might take time.

## **Recovery Procedure**

### **I**MPORTANT

- Recovering a storage device (hard disk and similar media) returns all data to its original factory settings.
- A commercially available USB keyboard is required to perform recovery. (Certain actions cannot be performed using a mouse.)
- If this product does not have a DVD drive, a commercially available DVD drive is required.
- Turn on this product and press the following key straight away;
- [F11] key for Atom N270 / Core 2 Duo P8400 Pre-installed Model users.
- [F12] key for Atom Z510 Pre-installed Model users.
- (2) The boot selection screen appears. First insert the recovery media into the DVD drive. Next use the [1] and [1] keys to select the appropriate DVD drive, and press Enter.
- (3) Acronis<sup>®</sup> True Image starts. Use the [1] and [4] keys on the keyboard to select "Restore", and then press Enter.
- (4) A confirmation dialog box appears. When recovery is performed, hard disk and CF card data is returned to its original factory settings and all data is deleted.

Use the left and right arrow keys on the keyboard to select "Yes", and then press Enter to start recovery.

### NOTE

- If the "Select destination of disk 1" window appears, select "Disk 1" and click "OK".
- (5) When recovery is complete, the "Rescue media completed performing

the operation" window appears. Remove the recovery media and then click "Exit" to restart this product.

### NOTE

- Remove the recovery media from the DVD drive before pressing "Exit". If the disk is not removed, the recovery setup window may reopen again.
- (6) Next perform the operating system setup. See "Operating System Setup" on page 1.

### **IMPORTANT**

- Acronis<sup>®</sup> True Image cannot be used to repair a storage device (hard disk or similar media) that has reached the end of its life, or is damaged (for example, if the BIOS does not recognize the storage media,) or has other hardware problems.
   If the storage device needs to be repaired or replaced, contact your local distributor.
- Storage devices are consumables. It is recommended that data is backed up regularly based on sufficient consideration of hardware specifications.
